

2426 STUDY SKILLS

The Board of Education believes that an essential part of a child's education is the development of the study skills and work habits that will prepare him/her for a lifetime of discipline learning.

The Superintendent shall develop, in consultation with the appropriate Building Principal and teaching staff members, a plan for the sequential introduction of training in the development of study skills and the formation of productive work habits. Such training shall be introduced early in the curriculum, shall be integrated with the curriculum, and shall be reinforced at each successive grade level.

Teaching staff members at all grade levels will be trained to help pupils develop appropriate learning techniques. Every reasonable effort should be made to convey to parent(s) or legal guardian(s) the importance of their cooperation in helping pupils develop the skills and habits essential to learning.
