### Kindergarten Supply List

4 Low odor Expo Dry Erase markers (bullet tip)  
20 glue sticks  
1 pair of Fiskars scissors (rounded tip)  
8 basic Crayola color markers (fat)  
1 24 pack Crayola crayons (skinny)  
2 marbled cover notebooks (black and white)  
2 containers of playdoh

**OPTIONAL**  
Highlighters  
Index cards  
Post-It notes  
Tennis balls- 1 4 pack  
1 box of baby wipes

- Name brand products are usually of better quality and hold up better to classroom use e.g. Fiskars scissors, Crayola products etc.
