When you are headed out to the stores, looking for a way to cool off during the dog days of summer; here are a few supplies that your child will need for the sixth grade:

- Pencil pouch - zipper style

- Black *Sharpie* marker (fine point)
- Black *Sharpie* marker (ultra-fine point)
- One Green single subject spiral notebook - Labeled Science

- One Red pocket folder - Labeled Social Studies
- A ½ inch binder - Labeled Literature/Language Arts
- One set of pocket dividers and filler paper

It is very important that the supplies be exactly as listed. All items should be labeled with your child's name. The sixth grade teachers will instruct the students on how to set up their materials in September. As these supplies run out, you will be notified so that replacements can be purchased. It is strongly recommended that you also have a dictionary for at home use.
